
SNEAK PREVIEW OF THE CULVER CITY HERITAGE MUSEUM

On Saturday, November 18, 2000, the Culver City Historical Society will present a "Sneak Preview" of the Culver City Heritage Museum at the Veteran's Memorial Building in Culver City.

The one day Expo/Performance event is designed to introduce the public and potential contributors to the Capital Campaign of the Culver City Heritage Museum.


Among the displays will be "The History of the Tongva/Gabriellino Indians", The History of the Spanish/Rancho period, a pictorial history of Culver City and the role of the entertainment industry in the development of the city that calls itself "The Heart of Screenland."

Screenings in the Garden Room during the day will include "Visions of Grandeur": Part One "Reel Life In Culver City", "The Last Days of The Pacific Electric" a short film by Ralph Larkin, three Academy Award nominated cartoons from Turner Entertainment followed by a lecture on cartoons by Martha Sigall, who worked first at the Warner Brothers Cartoon factory and later at MGM. and "Red Skelton's Great American Birthday Celebration", a tribute to the famed comedian on his 83rd birthday, produced by the Culver City Historical Society.



Doors will open at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday and the expo/screenings will run until 5:30pm.

NIGHTLIFE IN CULVER CITY

"Nightlife In Culver City" will cap off the Sneak Preview of the Culver City Heritage Museum" from 8:00 to 11:00 P.M. on Saturday, November 18 in the Lethridge Garden Room at the Veterans Memorial Building, 4117 Overland Avenue in Culver City.

Actor/Producer/Writer Robert Sacchi will be one of the hosts for "Nightlife In Culver City" a musical tribute to the heyday of the nightclubs that held court in Culver City from the 1920s through the end of World War Two.

Sacchi is best known for his portrayal of "The Man With Bogart's Face" which was filmed on the sound stages of MGM in Culver City. He has appeared in more than twenty feature films and is a frequent guest star on episodic television. Sacchi co-starred in the final episode of "Tales From The Crypt" called "You Murderer" directed by Academy Award winning director, Robert Zemekis for HBO.

Leading the musical tribute to Culver City Night Life will be jazz pianist Marty Harris who has appeared with Anita O'day, Diana Ross and Tom Jones among others.

Tickets for the evening's program is \$35.00 and will go to benefit the Culver City Historical Society's capital campaign to establish a Culver City Heritage Museum.
